Seneca Valley Community:

As the construction of our new building enters its final stage, we have once again had to make changes to student parking and student drop-off. In advance, I am asking for and thanking you for your patience and understanding.

### **Student Parking**

There are no parking spaces available for the general student population during the 2019-2020 school year. The limited number of spaces left available on the cafeteria side of the building by the construction crew are reserved for students with Internships or dual enrollment classes at Montgomery College built into their school-day schedules. These students should contact Mrs. Riddick to purchase a parking permit.

We recognize that this lack of available parking may create challenges for some of our students, but, unfortunately, we do not have any other viable options. The remaining parking spots in front of the school and in the auditorium lot are reserved for staff and a small number of visitors.

### **Student Drop-Off**

Because the construction project has taken over the cafeteria parking lot, there is no longer any student drop-off area on that side of the building. The sole remaining student drop-off area is now the auditorium parking lot. As you travel South East on Middlebrook Road, you will turn right into the lot. Once you enter for student drop-off, you will turn right and begin the loop around to the front of the auditorium stairs area. It is important that students are dropped off in this designated area only. Having a student attempt to get out of their vehicle prior to that point to avoid waiting in line creates an enormous safety issue. **Traffic flow is one-way traffic only. Please note that passing vehicles that are dropping students off is both dangerous and prohibited. Please be patient.** After dropping off your student, please continue on the one-way loop and exit campus by turning right onto Middlebrook Road.

At Seneca Valley High School, the safety of our student and staff members is paramount. It is important that these guidelines are adhered to at all times.
