Dear Parents/Guardians/Students of Walter Johnson High School:

This letter is to provide information regarding the PSAT/NMSQT (*Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test*), which will be administered on Wednesday, October 12, 2022 to all tenth and eleventh graders. Ninth grade will take a different practice test (see below). A revised bell schedule, which accommodates the efficient administration of the exam, is included in this letter and is available on the Walter Johnson website. Test groups will be emailed and posted on our website prior to October 12th.

The PSAT/NMSQT pre-administration includes an optional Student Search Service questionnaire which requests personal identifying information from students (racial/ethnic background, family income, parent/guardian's highest levels of education, etc.) This service can help students with particular backgrounds or interests receive information about educational and financial aid opportunities. Students may choose to opt-out of these questions and service.

10th and 11th grade students will receive a PSAT Student Guide. This material also includes sample test questions as well as answers to the most commonly asked questions about the PSAT/NMSQT. You may also access additional information about the PSAT/NMSQT here:

All 9th grade students will take a MOCK SAT exam. There will be no cost associated with this exam. The test is a courtesy of Capital Educators. Results and interpretation of the results will be shared in January. **Testing accommodations will not be provided for the 9th grade practice SAT.**

All 10th grade students will take the official 2022 PSAT for FREE. This test is the official PSAT that 10th graders take before taking the PSAT/NMSQT their junior year. Tests will be scored by the Educational Testing Service. Results and interpretation of the results will be shared in January. All 10th grade students are automatically registered.

All 11th grade students are strongly encouraged to take the official 2022 PSAT/NMSQT. The cost for juniors to take the PSAT is \$19.00. It is extremely important that all students take this exam in their junior year in order to qualify for merit scholarships and to be placed on updated college mailing lists. Only score reports from the junior year administration can be used for this purpose. Results and interpretation of the results will be shared in January. Please note, students who will take the PSAT/NMSQT must have been granted testing accommodations through The College Board in order to receive them. Students who have already been approved for accommodations on other College Board exams (AP, SAT, etc.) do not need to re-apply.
