Dear Parent/Guardians of Current 11<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:

Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) and Walter Johnson High School is moving forward with planning for the possibility of offering the PSAT to interested Grade 11 students on **January 26, 2021**, as health and safety conditions allow. The purpose of this letter is to provide information to students and parents about the PSAT registration process.

Based on College Board guidance and group size protocols, this PSAT administration would be offered to interested Grade 11 students only. Note that the January PSAT administration will have the same benefits as the October PSAT/NMSQT, including eligibility for programs administered by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation.

**Interested Grade 11 students should register and submit the \$17 testing fee no later than December 1, 2020.** Parents/guardians who need to request a fee waiver due to financial hardship should contact Mr. Heintze, [James\\_T\\_Heintze@mcpsmd.org](mailto:James_T_Heintze@mcpsmd.org).
