BBMS -RULES AND REGULATION FOR AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

STAYING AFTER SCHOOL

- Only students who are participating in staff supervised clubs/activities or academic help are allowed to be in the building (or outside recreation areas) after school.
- Students may not remain after school unsupervised.
- Students may not leave the building between the end of the school day (3:00pm) and the beginning of after-school activities.

ATTENDANCE.

 Daily attendance will be taken by activity leaders. If a student is repeatedly tardy to an activity, that student may lose the right to stay after school.

CONDUCT/BEHAVIOR

- All students must follow school rules when participating in after- school activities, including those concerning electronic devices.
- Students are not to be in the halls without a pass/permission from a staff member.

STAYING FOR HELP

• Students who are planning to stay afterschool to get extra help from a teacher must make sure the teacher is available before the end of the regular school day. Do not stay after if you are unsure teacher is available.

ACTIVITY BUSES

- Activity Buses are available most Wednesdays and Thursdays (starting Oct 7th).
- Activity Buses are only for students attending supervised activities after-school. Students will be
 issued activity Bus tickets during their activity. Only students with tickets will be allowed to
 ride the bus.
- Activity Buses arrive between 4:20pm-4:35pm. Bus Routes are posted on the activity board in the main hallway and available in the main office.
- If a student does not have school bus service, they cannot ride the Activity Bus. Routes are based on regular Banneker bus routes by Transportation. Bus Drivers are not permitted to drop off students in the "walking zone".

NOTICE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

If you are picking up a student after school, please use the "pick up" area (small lot near the tenniscourts) by 4:35 p.m. **PLEASE, DO NOT PICK YOUR STUDENT UP IN THE BUS CIRCLE IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL**. It is a fire lane and the lane for the after- school buses.
