ConnectEd Phone and Email Messages

Eastern Middle School uses the ConnectEd system to send important messages to Eastern families via telephone and email. These messages include a Sunday night message from Principal Matt Johnson about upcoming events; information for individual families regarding their child's attendance; emergency messages; and other messages as needed. It is critical that the school have accurate phone and email contact information on file so that you receive these important messages. PTSA Email Listserv

All families with access to the Internet and an email account are encouraged to join the PTSA's group listserv. The morning announcements that are broadcast daily into all classrooms are posted on the listserv so that parents and guardians are aware of activities and opportunities shared with students.
