

# Eastern Middle School

## School Supplies List

### **The following materials are required for all students:**

- Three-ring binder - at least 2" wide
- Eight subject dividers for the three-ring binder
- #2 pencils with erasers
- Ballpoint pens in blue ink or black ink
- Wide-ruled loose-leaf paper
- Highlighters

### **The following materials are suggested for students:**

- Pencil pouch
- Backpack – used to carry materials to and from home
- USB Flash Drive (minimum 2 GB)

***Additional supplies may be required for certain classes. Teachers will share information about additional supplies that will be needed during the first week of school.***

### **Additional Information:**

- Permanent markers (including Sharpies) are not allowed at school.
- Please note that backpacks may not be carried to class. All backpacks must fit within locker space. A luggage style bag with wheels and a pull handle will *not* fit in lockers.
- Graphing calculators are necessary for the student to demonstrate mastery of the mathematics curriculum, beginning with Algebra 1. A graphing calculator is not needed before Algebra 1. Students are encouraged to buy their own graphing calculators to use during Algebra 1 and subsequent mathematics courses. The TI-84 Plus is the suggested calculator and it can be purchased at most local stores including Target, Staples, and Wal-Mart. Eastern will rent a limited supply of graphing calculators to students for a \$45 refundable fee. Students must return calculators in working order at the end of the year in order to get the fee refunded. Students that rent calculators and do not return them or the calculator is not returned in working order will be charged an additional \$45 fee.
- All students will be provided one agenda book the first day of school. The agenda book provides valuable information about Eastern Middle School including school contact information, student code of conduct, and the policies and procedures. Most importantly, the agenda book is an important tool for organization providing a place for students to write down homework assignments for each class. The agenda book can also be used as communication tool between the school and home. Lost agenda books must be replaced. The cost of the replacement agenda book is \$5.00 per book.
