











You have the 10 characteristics of a successful middle school student!

Positive Academic Identity		Having a positive sense of self as a learner and a commitment to learning; able to persist through challenges; seeing self as an integral part of the learning community.
Critical Disposition		Questioning presented/found knowledge, seeking evidence to support opinions and decisions, and considering multiple perspectives.
Reflective Thinker and Learner		Understanding one's strengths and challenges, and making connections and adjusting thinking based on new learning and existing knowledge.
Persistent		Working diligently and applying effective strategies to achieve a goal or solve a problem; continuing in the face of obstacles and competing pressures.
Creates/Innovates		Developing multiple ways of thinking and understanding diverse perspectives to produce new ideas and generate multiple solutions.
Problem Solves		Working through concrete or abstract challenges to reach understanding and solutions.
Collaborates		Working effectively with others to achieve individual and common goals and objectives.
Values Diversity		Understanding the unique and positive aspects of self while seeking and seeing other perspectives (culture, age, gender, learning/thinking, race, etc.) as an asset to learning and problem solving.
Shows Empathy		Identifying with the feelings, thoughts, and perspectives of others and treating others with care and respect.
Communicates		Sharing thinking/emotions effectively in multiple ways, seeking to understand others, and responding effectively in written, spoken or signed, visual, and artistic forms.
