### **Instructional Focus**

Parkland's Instructional Leadership Team met in July and attended several trainings to plan for the upcoming school year. We also analyzed data from parents, students, and staff, including classroom, county and state assessments, in order to create our instructional goals for this school year. ### **New Student Orientation**

There will be a new student orientation on Thursday, August 29, 2019 from 8:15 am to 12:00 pm. A regular bus schedule will run that day. If your student rides the bus, carefully look at the bus schedules on the school's website. New parents and families, please join me on the morning August 29, 2019 from 8:15 am to 8:45 am in the media center. All returning students can come back to school on Tuesday, September 3, 2019.

### **First Week of School**

The first day of school is on **Tuesday, September 3, 2019** from 8:15 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Upon arrival to school during the first week of school:

- Grade 6 Students will report directly to the cafeteria and sit by their Homerooms.
- Grade 7 and Grade 8 students will report to the gym and sit by their Homerooms.

### **Drop-off and Pick-up**

Parents who drive their child to/from school are strongly encouraged to drop their children at the front of the building. Students can be dropped off in the morning as early as 7:50 a.m. unless a previous arrangement is made with a teacher. Cars entering the parking lot should follow the traffic around to the front of the building, then continue around the loop to the exit. In the morning, there is no parking allowed anywhere along the parent drop-off loop and driveway and no standing at the entrance to the loop. Please note that the driveway to the left of the school as you are facing the school, is for school bus use only and is not to be used as a drop-off area. Blue lined parking spaces are only available after the buses leave during the day until 2:00 p.m. on regular school days. Please pick up your children promptly at dismissal at 3:00 p.m.

### **Athletics (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Graders)**

This is reminder to all 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents that if your child is going to tryout/play sports this year, they MUST have physicals on file before tryouts. ### **Vaccinations for 7<sup>th</sup> Graders**

All incoming 7<sup>th</sup> grade students need to have these required vaccines: Meningococcal (MCV4) & Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis/whooping cough). Please turn in all vaccination forms, if you have not already done so, into the main office at the school this summer.

### **Food and Nutrition Services Program Information**

Students who were eligible for FARMS (Free and Reduced-Meals System) during the 2018-2019 school year are eligible to receive free or reduced-price meals through October 16, 2019, or until a new application is processed. This provides benefits to eligible students while the applications are being processed for this year. Once the 2019-2020 applications are processed, that eligibility determination carries through the school year or until another application is processed.

#### ***Application Process:***

- ***Online applications:*** For faster processing, households are encouraged to apply online at [www.MySchoolApps.com](http://www.MySchoolApps.com)
- ***Scanned Paper Applications:*** In order to decrease processing time, the 2019-2020 applications have been redesigned and will be electronically scanned. Due to this change, only ORIGINAL applications can be processed.
- Use only one application (online or paper) for all children in a household who attend MCPS, even if the students attend different schools.
- As a federal government information on the application changes every year, only 2019-2020 applications may be used.
