Dear Parents/Guardians,

Vision and Hearing screenings were held at your child's school on December 19, 20, 21 and 22.

All children enrolled in Grade 8 were screened for hearing and vision problems if they were in school on the screening day(s).

If your child did not pass the screening, you will have already received a referral letter, via US mail, with the notice of your child's not passing and specific results of your child's hearing and/or vision screening, as well as what to do with this information.

If you did not receive this referral form in the US Mail and your child was present on the screening day, then your child passed the screening.

School based vision screenings may not detect every vision problem.
