Algebra Support: Students can get support with Algebra concepts and homework. Tuesdays with Ms. Ramos starting September 25th.

Drama Club: Do you love being on stage, or think you may enjoy helping create stage magic behind the scenes? If so, then the drama club is for you! Open to all students, the drama club will meet weekly throughout the first semester to discuss theatre, read plays, and work on audition techniques. This work will culminate in a December Drama Club showcase of scenes and monologues. After winter break, the focus will shift from weekly club meetings to rehearsals for the school show, which will be open to all students. Wednesdays with Mr. Smith starting September 26th.

Glee Club: Glee Club: Membership by audition with Mr. Nassar. Small vocal group talented vocal students interested in singing a wide range of styles and music. Includes opportunity to sing solos.
