Tilden PTSA Presents: Executive Functioning Skills to Manage Remote Learning

These are unprecedented times, and without the benefit of many of the structures that are an inherent part of the physical school day, skills such as organization, prioritization and time-management are more important than ever to student success. This workshop, tailored for the Tilden Middle School community, will introduce simple, concrete supports that students and parents can bring to remote learning, which will have an immediate positive impact. We'll consider tools for deciding which tasks to tackle when, how to identify strategies that work best for the task at hand, and the kinds of planning systems that complement online platforms such as Google Classroom.

The workshop will be presented by Jenna Prada, the creator and director of Private Prep's Executive Functioning Programs. Ms. Prada has a Masters in Education and is a licensed teacher and administrator with a decade of experience. The program will include a presentation and opportunity for questions and answers.
