My focus this year will be "Continuing Excellence with E.Q.U.I.T.Y." E.Q.U.I.T.Y stands for **Engaging** educational experiences that are inviting and exciting for all students. Students will build stronger relationships with peers and staff. All students will receive high **Quality** Instruction every day in all classes. We will approach this with **Understanding** of what we have been through, a pandemic, and how we adapt and lean in to our new normal. What's been happening this summer?

What's new this year?

This year we have new programming for our students. We are now an Accelerated and Enriched Instruction school which focuses on students' learning may be enriched and accelerated; and, students may participate in advanced-level coursework at their local schools. Instruction is differentiated to provide all students appropriate pacing and support necessary for advanced-level learning. Our staff has been working hard to provide high quality lessons that are engaging for all students.

We have added two new Advanced Placement Classes this year to the high school, AP Language and Composition and AP Spanish. We will continue to provide high level challenging classes to our high school students to prepare them for life after high school.

We have a new Self Development Program called The RISE Program which stands for RICA Individualized Stages of Enrichment. "This program is designated to promote positive social and emotional personal growth, utilizing staff guidance, support and education to emphasize student awareness, accountability and self-responsibility for all RICA students." 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Student Handbook). Students will have an opportunity to learn about the new program during the first week of school orientation period.

Finally, as a district we are focusing on Equity in all schools. This summer the Instructional Leadership team made up of teacher leaders looked at policies and practices at RICA and how we approach the work differently to support all students.
